

How Can the Disability Resource Coordinator (DRC) help you?

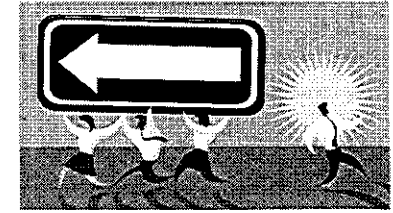
The Disability Resource Coordinator :

- will make sure that people with disabilities can use Chautauqua Works.
- will make sure that people with disabilities know about services that will help them work.
- 
 - will help to remove employment barriers.
 - will help people with disabilities get and keep jobs with wages they can live on.
 - will help others be aware of the needs of people with disabilities.
- will provide tools for working with people with disabilities.
- will link people with disabilities to employers.
- will help you understand the Ticket to Work program.
